



- → Jesus concludes His public ministry with a scathing rebuke of the Jewish leaders because of their hypocrisy -(Mark 12:38–40; Mat 23:1– 39; Lk 20:45–47)
- ♦ In stark contrast Jesus commends a widow's sacrificial giving (Mark 12:41-44; Luke 21:1-4).



MARK 12:41-44 (NKJV)

41 Now Jesus sat opposite the treasury and saw how the people put money into the treasury. And many who were rich put in much. 42 Then one poor widow came and threw in two mites, which make a quadrans.



MARK 12:41-44 (NKJV)

43 So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all those who have given to the treasury; 44 for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood."



DO WE GIVE TO THE LORD HOW & WHAT WE SHOULD?

- ♦ We are stewards of God our blessings are to be used in service to Him & bearing fruit in the Kingdom (1 Pet 4:10)
- ◆ The manner, amount, and quality of what we give to the Lord, manifest our love and respect, (honor) for Him, (Mal 1:6; Prov. 3:9)







The Value of The Widows Two Mites

Jesus was aware of how much they give. (Mark 12:41,42)

6.79 λεπτόν, οῦ n: a copper (or bronze) coin worth 1/2 of a quadrans or 1/128 of a denarius—'lepton, tiny coin. . . . 'a very small coin' or 'a coin with very little value' or 'money that was not worth very much.'

The Value of The Widows Two Mites

→ Jesus commended the poor widow - the one who actually gave the most . . . (Mark 12:43,44)

Mark 12:43-44 (NKJV)

⁴³ So He called His disciples to Himself and said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that this poor widow has put in more than all those who have given to the treasury; ⁴⁴ for they all put in out of their abundance, but she out of her poverty put in all that she had, her whole livelihood."



DO WE GIVE TO THE LORD HOW & WHAT WE SHOULD?

- ◆ Acceptable giving is not determined by the amount of money given but the amount of sacrifice involved (Mark 12:43,44; 2 Cor 8:1-3)
- ♦ In our giving, we either -
 - * Rob God (Mal. 3:8) OR
 - * Lay Up Treasures in Heaven (Matt.6:19-21)



DO WE GIVE TO THE LORD HOW & WHAT WE SHOULD?

- → To ask HOW MUCH do I have to give is to ask the wrong question!
- → The amount we MUST give cannot be determined on a strict "percentage basis." (Gen 14:20; Deut 14:22,23; 1 Cor 16:1,2; 2 Cor. 9:7; Mat. 15:1-9)
- → How much will those who have fully given themselves to the Lord give back to Him - (2 Cor 8:5)

- ♦ NOT of necessity ~ 9:7



- → Being good stewards of our possessions not limited to what we put into the collection plate on the first day of the week (Mat 15:1-9; 1 Tim 5:8,16)
- → However, our collective work depends upon the free will offering of our members - (1 Cor 16:1,2; 14:26; 2 Cor. 8,9; 11:8; Phil. 4:15-19; Acts 4:37; 6:1-7)

FELLOWSHIP OF GIVING PART OF WORSHIP

- having received from Epaphroditus the things sent from you, a sweet-smelling aroma, an acceptable sacrifice, well pleasing to God. Philippians 4:18
- Note 16 But do not forget to do good and to share, for with such sacrifices God is well pleased. Hebrews 13:16



WE SHOULD GIVE

- → To please God (Heb 13:16)
- → To Be Christ-like
 (2 Corinthians 8:8-12)
- → To have treasure in Heaven (Luke 12:33,34)
- → To glorify God
 (2 Corinthians 9:11-13)
- ★ To set a good example (2 Corinthians 8:1,2).



WE SHOULD GIVE

- → Without display (Mt. 6:1-4)
- → Because God has appointed that the Church use money in its work (1 Corinthians 16:1,2; Acts 4:34,35; 5:1ff; 11:29; Romans 15:26,27; 2 Cor 11:8; Phili 4:15,16)
- → Out of zeal for the work of the Lord (Rom. 12:8).



OUR GIVING


- Should Involve SACRIFICE- 2 Co 8:9

⁶ But this *I say:* He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. 7 So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or of necessity; for God loves a cheerful giver. 8 And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.
