


#### WALKING BY FAITH



# Worship of A Local Church



- ◆ It is important "HOW" we worship! - John 4:23-24
- ◆ There are MANY different ways to engage in "FALSE" worship! - Mat 15:7-9
- ◆ The "PURPOSE" of worship is to honor & glorify God -The ONLY way to honor & glorify God in our worship is to worship AS HE SAYS!



ACTS 2:42 (NKJV)


42 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers.

- Praying Regularly /Consistently / Habitually /& Courageously



- ★ A fire escape Prov 1:24-33; Jam 1:6,7


#### WHAT IS PRAYER?



PRAYER IS THE SINCERE DESIRE OF THE HEART EXPRESSED TO GOD IN WORDS:

- ♦ Not necessarily audible 1 Sam 1:13
- ♦ Not necessarily with full knowledge - Rom 8:26
- But communicating our desires to God - Rom 10:1



- ♦ Thanksgiving Eph 5:20; 1 Thes 5:18
- ◆ Confession 1 John 1:9
- ♦ Supplications (requests) & intercessions - 1 Tim 2:1-3


#### WHEN SHOULD WE PRAY?



#### INDIVIDUALLY:

- ♦ Without ceasing 1 Thes 5:17; Luke 18:1
- ◆ Continuing in prayer Col 4:2
- ◆ David prayed morning noon & evening - Psalm 55:17
- ♦ Before a meal 1 Tim 4:4,5

#### TOGETHER:

- ♦ Without ceasing 1 Thes 5:17
- ◆ Continuing in prayer Col 4:2; Acts 2:42
- ♦ In times of trial Acts 4:23-31; 12:5,12; Rom 8:26,27
- ♦ In times of need Mt 18:19,20;
  Acts 27:35; 1 Tim. 4:3-5
- ♦ In preparation Acts 13:3; 14:23


# FOR WHOM SHOULD WE PRAY?

- ♦ All Christians Eph 6:18; James 5:16


# FOR WHAT SHOULD WE PRAY?

- God's will to be done Mat 6:9-13 [Matt. 26:39]
- Necessities of life Mat 6:11.
- Knowledge, wisdom, & understanding of God's will - Ps 119:169-172. []ames 1:5,6; Col. 1:9,10; Eph 3:3-5]
- Forgiveness of sins Mat 6:12; Acts 8:22,24; 1 Jn 1:9,10
- Ability to recognize and resist temptation - Mat 6:13. [Matt. 26:41; Eph. 6:11-18; 2 Cor. 13:7; Luke 22:31,32; John 17:14-16]

#### FOR WHAT SHOULD WE PRAY?



- ✦ Health / freedom / safety 3 Jn 2; 1 Tim 2:1-2; Acts 12:1,5,12.
- ♦ Safety in travel / care for loved ones we are separated from Acts 21:5.
- Peace, courage, joy Phili 4:6,7.
- ♦ Opportunities to preach & teach with boldness & clarity Col 4:3; Ep 6:18-20
- ♦ Support for preachers Phili 1:3-5.
- ♦ Strength Col 1:9-11. [Eph. 3:14-19;
  2 Thes 1:11]

## FOR WHAT SHOULD WE PRAY?



- Faithfulness, good works, a life pleasing to God Phili 1:3-6,9-11.
  [Col. 1:9-11; 4:12; Jo 17:9-12; 1 Thes 3:10-13; 2 Thes 1:11]
- ◆ Patience, long-suffering Col 1:11.
- ♦ Grace & mercy 2 Cor 4:15. [Ps 4:1; 86:3-6; 1 Cor. 1:4]
- ◆ Love Phili 1:9. [1 Thess. 3:10-12; Eph. 3:14-19]
- ♦ Unity John 17:20-23.
- ♦ Eternal life, eternal glory Jn 17:24-26



- Bowed heads 1 Chr 29:20, Lk 18:13
- Eyes lifted toward heaven Jn 17:1ff (Jesus). [John 11:41; Matt. 14:19]



- We Must Pray in Faith James 1:5-7


#### HOW ARE WE TO PRAY?




#### MUST BE PROPERLY ADDRESSED




# THE PEOPLE OF GOD ARE A PEOPLE OF PRAYER




