


### Need To Heed Godly Instruction



- One should not part with truth under any circumstance!



<sup>18</sup> Of His own will He brought us forth by the word of truth, that we might be a kind of firstfruits of His creatures.



<sup>21</sup> Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.







#### The Need For & Value of "The Truth"






- There are many enemies of the truth (Phili 3:16-18)

  - Apathetic, inconsistent or rud∈ Christians????




- Too many professing Christians have "sold the truth"




#### How Much Is The Truth Worth?





### THE TRUTH - To Be "Bought"




- Requires effort too many today are intellectually lazy! Acts 17:11; Psalm 1:2; Prov. 2:4
- Requires proper attitude Love, sincerity, humility & meekness Psalms 119:97-104; 1 Peter 2:2; Psalm 25:9; James 1:21
- \* Requires application Too many are hearers of the word and not doers Heb 4:12; James 1:22

### THE TRUTH - Nothing But The Truth




- ♦ Only the truth (John 8:32; 14:6)
- ♦ Must be willing to accept all of the truth - (Psa 119:160; Gal. 1:6-9)
- \* The need to examine doctrine before you buy it (1 Jn. 4:1; 1 Thess. 5:21; Rev. 2:2, Acts 17:11, 12)
- ◆ Eve bought a lie, (Gen. 3:1-6) Many today are also buying Satan's lies instead of God's truth

### THE TRUTH - Nothing But The Truth



- ♦ Why would anyone not want to buy the truth? -
  - No fear of God (Prov 1:7)
  - > Has not received a love for it (2 Thes 2:10-11)
  - Has pleasure in unrighteousness (2 Thes 2:12; John 3:19-21; Rom 1:18,19)
  - ▶ Pride (1 Tim 6:3-5; Pro 26:12;)



### THE TRUTH - Nothing But The Truth




♦ Why would anyone not want to buy the truth? -

2 TIMOTHY 3:1-7 (NKJV)

3 unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, 5 having a form of godliness but denying its power.

And from such people turn away!


♦ Why would anyone not want to buy the truth? -

<sup>6</sup> For of this sort are those who creep into households and make captives of gullible women loaded down with sins,


led away by various lusts, <sup>7</sup> always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth.

### THE TRUTH - Nothing But The Truth




- ♦ Why would anyone not want to buy the truth? -
  - Deceived (Mat. 15:14; 2 Pet. 2:19)
  - Duplicity of character (Ezek. 33:31; Jas. 1:21-24)
  - Shallowness of heart (Mk. 4:16, 17a)
  - Eph. 4:14)

#### THE TRUTH - Can Be Sold




- Israel sold the truth (Jer. 9:1-14)
- Exchanged the truth for a lie -(Gen 3; Rom. 1:18-25)
- Sell the truth for temporal profit
   (2 Pet. 2:1-3; Mat 16:26)
- We can be turned from the truth
   by error (2 Tim. 4:4; Tit. 1:14)
- ♦ The truth can be wandered away from (2 Tim. 2:18; James 5:19)


### Do NOT Sell - THE TRUTH!



- ♦ Under any circumstance -NOT for earthly profit or sensual pleasure - Not to avoid hardship or persecution ...
- ◆ B∈ Wise A wise person will not permit himself to be reasoned out of it or laughed out of it.
- We should buy it (regardless of the cost) and refuse to sell it (regardless of what Satan offers us for it).

#### 2 Thessalonians 2:9-15 (NKJV)
