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



<sup>17</sup> Then it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that God did not lead them by way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for God said, "Lest perhaps the people change their minds when they see war, and return to Egypt." <sup>18</sup> So God led the people around by way of the wilderness of the Red Sea. And the children of Israel went up in orderly ranks out of the land of Egypt. - **Exadus 13:17–18 (NKJV)** 

God led them the LONG way - Ex 13:17,18



'21 And the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way, and by night in a pillar of fire to give them light, so as to go by day and night. <sup>22</sup> He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire by night from before the people. - **Exadus 13:21–22 (NKJV)** 

They could know they were going the way the Lord wanted them to go - Ex 13:20-22



10 ... So they were very afraid, and the children of Israel cried out to the Lord. 11 Then they said to Moses, "Because there were no graves in Egypt, have you taken us away to die in the wilderness? Why have you so dealt with us, to bring us up out of Egypt? 12 Is this not the word that we told you in Egypt, saying, 'Let us alone that we may serve the Egyptians'? For it would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than that we should die in the wilderness."

The Lord led them to a dead end- Ex 14:1-4 Pharaoh's army closes in - Ex 14:5-10 People afraid & complain - Ex 14:11,12

And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. <sup>14</sup> The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace." - Exadus 14:13,14

### The Lord Saved them that day - Ex 14:13-31

<sup>30</sup> So the Lord saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians dead on the seashore.

Thus Israel saw the great work which the Lord had done in Egypt; so the people feared the Lord, and believed the Lord and His servant Moses. - Exodus 14:30,31


- They longed for their former life of plenty Ex. 16:1-3; Num. 11:5

- The Lord provided Ex. 16:13-31; Num 11:20



- Taskmasters that afflicted them. Lives that were bitter with hard bondage all their service with rigor. Ex 1:11-22
- Their newborn sons killed, or cast into the river. Ex1:16
- But they had FOOD: Cucumbers, melons, leeks, onions and garlic!!!!

- Are God's provisions, way & promises enough?



   19:5-6; Deut 28:9-45






- Those who stand for truth will suffer hardships!! 2


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

- The next day the congregation complained even more
  Num. 16:41-49.




- We must respect those whom God gives authority



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


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

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### HEBREWS 3:12-4:1 (NKJV)

12 Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God; <sup>13</sup> but exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. 14 For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end,

### HEBREWS 3:12-4:1 (NKJV)

15 while it is said: "Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion." 16 For who, having heard, rebelled? Indeed, was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses? 17 Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they would not enter His rest, but to those who did not obey?

### HEBREWS 3:12-4:1 (NKJV)

19 So we see that they could not enter in because of unbelief. 1 Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it.
