

NOT COMPLACENCY -

Complacency is a careless satisfaction with one's life & state – An attitude of apathy, a disregard & Unconcern for one's deficiencies in character, work ethic & service.

Vines EDONTW - autarkeia (αὐτάρκεια, 841), "contentment, satisfaction with what one has," is found in 1 Tim. 6:6. . . . -

Without - worry, fear, anxiety, COMPETITION, (i.e., jealousy & envy)

LUKE 3:14 (NKJV)

14 Likewise the soldiers asked him, saying, "And what shall we do?" So he said to them, "Do not intimidate anyone or accuse falsely, and be content with your wages."

LUKE 12:15 (NKJV)

15 And He said to them,
"Take heed and beware of
covetousness, for one's life
does not consist in the
abundance of the things he
possesses."



CONTENTMENT IS ...

HEBREWS 13:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵ Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." ⁶ So we may boldly say: "The Lord is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?"



CONTENTMENT IS ...

2 CORINTHIANS 12:9-10 (NKJV)

⁹ And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.
¹⁰ Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ's sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

¹³ These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.


























- Patience a quiet bearing of injuries Eph 4:2; 1 Cor 13:7; Gal 6:2

- Be faithful in your professed allegiance to the Lord Jesus a quiet bearing of injuries 11-13; 1 Thes 2:12; Lk 12:8
- ★ Focus on the glory & praise worthy of the Lord Jesus 14-16; Heb 12:1-3




PHILIPPIANS 4:4-13 (NKJV)
