## The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons THERE IS NO PARTIALITY

prosopolempsia ... (προσωποληψία, 4382) denotes "respect of persons, partiality" ... the fault of one who, when responsible to give judgment, has respect to the position, rank, popularity, or circumstances of men, instead of their intrinsic conditions, preferring the rich and powerful to those who are not so, *Rom*.

# The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons THERE IS NO PARTIALITY

Acts 10:34 ("God is no respecter of persons") ... "prosopolemptes, a word that refers to a judge who looks at a man's face instead of at the facts of the case, and makes a decision based on whether or not he likes the man" (Lenski, 1961, p. 418).

# The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons THERE IS NO PARTIALITY

Any human judge might show undue favor to a plaintiff or a defendant because of familial relations, private friendship, bribery, rank, power, or political affiliation.

# The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons THERE IS NO PARTIALITY

God, the perfect Judge, cannot be tempted by any of the things that might tempt a human judge to show unfair partiality.

# The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons WHAT IT DOES NOT MEAN

- God's love extended to all men but few will receive it John 3:16; Titus 2:11,12; Mat 7:13,14; 2 Pet 3:9
- God does not hear sinners

   but always hears His
   children John 9:31; Acts
   10:1-4; 1 John 5:14,15

# The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons WHAT IT DOES NOT MEAN



Material or physical blessings are not equally given to all - Phili 4:12,13; 2 Cor 12:7-10; Luke 16:19-31; Job

Everyone does not receive the same opportunities to hear the gospel - Rom 1:19-21; Col. 1:5,23; Mark 16:15,16; Acts 17:26,27

#### The IMPARTIALITY of GOD God No Respecter of Persons WHAT IT DOES NOT MEAN



> That there are no distinctions in roles & functions - Eph 5:22-24,33; 1 Cor 14:34;

2 Tim 2:11-15

That we all have the same abilities, opportunities & responsibilities in service -Rom 12:3-8; 1 Cor 12:14-30

#### God No Respecter of Persons GOD HAS CONCLUDED ALL UNDER SIN



- Every Accountable Individual Who Has Sinned Stands Guilty Before God (Is 59:1,2; Rom 3:9,10)
- Who Has NOT Sinned? (Rom 3:23; 1 John 1:10)
  - God will NOT arbitrarily save some and then condemn others!! (Ez 18:19-32; Mt 11:28-30)

## God No Respecter of Persons GOD REDEMPTIVELY LOVES ALL MEN



- God so loved the world (John 3:16; 6:33)
- Jesus tasted "death for every man," - (Heb 2:9)
- "Jesus is" the propitiation for the sins of the whole world," (1 John 2:2)

## God No Respecter of Persons GOD REDEMPTIVELY LOVES ALL MEN

Titus 2:11–12 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,

teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,

1 Timothy 2:4 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

## God No Respecter of Persons GOD REDEMPTIVELY LOVES ALL MEN

2 Peter 3:9 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us,

not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

### God No Respecter of Persons PROVIDED ONE WAY OF SALVATION FOR ALL



- "... for if you do not believe that I am He, you will die in your sins." (John 8:24)
- "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)
  - 'Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.' (John 14:6)

#### God No Respecter of Persons PROVIDED ONE WAY OF SALVATION FOR ALL




- God does NOT save one person one way and another person in some other way (Rom 1:16,17)

  - Continu∈ in th∈ faith (1 Cor 15:58; 2 Peter 1:5-10)

## God No Respecter of Persons THERE IS ONE CHURCH FOR ALL

- Jesus promised to build "His church" (Mat 16:18; Acts 2:47)
- Jesus shed His blood for His church (Acts 20:28)
- Jesus is the head of His church (Eph 5:22,23; 4:4)
- Jesus adds all the saved toHis church (Acts 2:47)
- Jesus is NOT divided!! (1 Cor 1:10-13)

## God No Respecter of Persons THERE IS ONE STANDARD FOR ALL



- All MUST be done in the name of Christ – (Col 3:17)
- God does not give you a message me a different message and someone else another message (1 Pet 4:11)
  - Those who make their own standard will be condemned (2 John 1:9; Mat 15:9; Gal 1:6-9; Rev 22:18,19)

### God No Respecter of Persons all will be judged by same standard



#### John 12:48-50 (NKJV)

<sup>48</sup> He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him-the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day ... <sup>50</sup> And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak."

### God No Respecter of Persons ALL WILL BE JUDGED BY SAME STANDARD



Matthew 7:21-23 (NKJV)

<sup>21</sup> "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name,

### God No Respecter of Persons all Will be judged by same standard

#### 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> and to *give* you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, <sup>8</sup> in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup>These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, . . .

### God No Respecter of Persons ALL WILL BE JUDGED BY SAME STANDARD

#### Romans 2:1–16 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore you are inexcusable, O man, whoever you are who judge, for in whatever you judge another you condemn yourself; for you who judge practice the same things. <sup>2</sup> But we know that the judgment of God is according to truth against those who practice such things. <sup>3</sup> And do you think this, O man, you who judge those practicing such things, and doing the same, that you will escape the judgment of God?

### God No Respecter of Persons all will be judged by same standard

#### Romans 2:1–16 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? <sup>5</sup> But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, 6 who "will render to each one according to his deeds":

#### Romans 2:1–16 (NKJV)

<sup>7</sup> eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality; 8 but to those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness—indignation and wrath, 9 tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek; 10 but glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 11 For there is no partiality with God.

### God No Respecter of Persons all Will be judged by same standard

Men may be biased – swayed by wealth, popularity, power, status, familial relations, etc.. God IS NOT!!

#### God No Respecter of Persons NOR CAN WE BE A RESPECTER OF PERSONS

Deuteronomy 1:17

"You shall not show partiality in judgment; you shall hear the small as well as the great."

James 2:9

"But if you show partiality, you commit sin, and are convicted by the law as transgressors"



### God No Respecter of Persons The same invitation is extended to all
