"Life under the sun"



- The message of Ecclesiastes "Vanity of vanities! All is vanity." Over and over we are reminded that life is frequently disappointing, unfair, oppressive, tragic, and SEEMINGLY without point or meaning.

 - *7 = perfect # / 8 = eternity . . . ?

 - * It is IMPORTANT to take advantage of opportunities when they appear Jam 4:17; Lk 12:48;

- Most apply the principle to benevolence - but can also be applied to:
 - ** Being actively involved in good works Our influence Mt 5:13-16; Rom 12:1,2; 1 Pet 3:1-6
 - * Mercy / Forgiveness Luke 6:38
 - * Evangelism / sowing the seed Mat 13:18-23; 1 Cor 3:5-8; 9:19-23

The Value of Persistent Faithfulness

ACT IN FAITH DESPITE THE PROBLEMS OF LIFE



- Problems of life will come, and there is nothing that we can do to stop them (7:3).
 - *We cannot allow our focus to be on the negatives of life. Pr. 3:27; 20:4; 22:13; Mat 14:28-31
 - * We CANNOT allow any APPARENT lack of success to dissuade us from continued faithfulness 1 Cor 3:5-8; James 4:17
 - * God will not accept our excuses!!

- When dealing with God, there will always be that element of mystery and wonder (7:3).
 - * There are MANY things we CANNOT know we CANNOT comprehend Deut 29:29; Rom 11:33
 - * If we REALLY TRUST God we will continue to obey His commands, even if and when we do NOT fully understand the why of it, or the how it will accomplish God's will 2 Ki 5; Gen 16-18; etc


FAITHFULNESS BRINGS FULFILLMENT


FAITHFULNESS BRINGS FULFILLMENT



- A believer is to enjoy their physical life (Ecc 2:24; 3:12,22; 5:18; 8:15).
- There is beauty in every stage of life (Eccl 3:1-11)
- True joy can ONLY be realized by seeing things through the eyes of faith (Phili 4:6-13).

The Earlier The Better

REMEMBER GOD IN YOUTH



- Youth is to be enjoyed but NOT wasted TRUE JOY IS ONLY EXPERIENCED IN OBEDIENCE TO GOD 11:9a
- We will give account to God how we live 11:9b
- So be joyful be holy youth will not last - 11:10

2 Corinthians 5:10 (NKJV)

¹⁰ For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things *done* in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.

The Eternal Reward of Faith

I Peter I:6-9 (NKJV)

⁶ In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, ⁷ that the genuineness of your faith, *being* much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, ⁸ whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, ⁹ receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of *your* souls.


The Eternal Reward of Faith
