


# Equipped For Victory"

- Paul returns to the defense of his apostolic authority 10:1-13:10
  - Weapons spiritual, not carnal 10:1-6
  - Paul's authority is from the Lord – 10:7-11
  - Who the LORD commends is what matters 10:12-17


#### 2 CORINTHIANS 10:1-6 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christwho in presence am lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you. <sup>2</sup> But I beg you that when I am present I may not be bold with that confidence by which I intend to be bold against some, who think of us as if we walked according to the flesh. <sup>3</sup> For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.

#### 2 CORINTHIANS 10:1-6 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, <sup>5</sup> casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, <sup>6</sup> and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.


# Paul's personal appeal – 1,2



<sup>2</sup> Corinthians 10:1 (NKJV)
<sup>1</sup> Now I, Paul, myself am pleading with you by the meekness and gentleness of Christ—who in presence am lowly among you, but being absent am bold toward you.

- I, Paul, myself an intensified form of pleading — (Gal 5:2)
- "By the meekness and gentleness of Christ" — qualities absent in his opponents / yet qualities they knew imitated Christ - (Mt 11:29; 1 Cor 11:1; 1 Pet 2:21)
- Paul uses the words of his antagonists - which were meant to subvert his authority - 10:10


# Paul's personal appeal – 1,2



<sup>2</sup> But I beg *you* that when I am present I may not be bold with that confidence by which I intend to be bold against some, who think of us as if we walked according to the flesh.

- I beg of you Paul would prefer not to act with severity in their presence, but he can and will (1 Cor 4:19-21; 2 Cor 13:2,10)
- "I intend to be bold against some"
  - He specifies the some later
  - (2 Cor. 11:13).
- "who think of us as if we walked according to the flesh" — they attributed to Paul their own motives and tactics - (1 Cor 4:19)

## Paul's war – 3-5



<sup>2</sup> Corinthians 10:3 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup> For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh.

- though we walk in the flesh in the body, with all its incidental infirmities and trials without implying sin, as "according to the flesh" does (Gal 2:20; Phil 1:22-24; 1Tim 3:16).
- This battle is fought in the minds of men - (Note - Arguments; Knowledge; Thoughts - vs. 5)

## Paul's war – 3-5

#### THE WEAPONS OF OUR WARFARE

- 2 Corinthians 10:4–5 (NKJV) <sup>4</sup> For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, <sup>5</sup> casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,
- are not carnal -
  - E.g., weapons that may be used "AGAINST" the flesh– (Guns, bombs, swords . . .)
  - E.g., weapons that are "OF" the flesh. (NOT Psychology Secular Education Human Wisdom or Positive Thinking)

#### THE WEAPONS OF OUR WARFARE


- 2 Corinthians 10:4–5 (NKJV) <sup>4</sup> For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,
- but mighty in God the word of God!
  - Living & powerful He 4:12
  - Can produce faith Ro 10:17
  - Able to save souls Jam 1:21
  - Able to regenerate 1Pe 1:23
- Unless we use this Word, all our efforts will be in vain

#### THE WEAPONS OF OUR WARFARE


- 2 Corinthians 10:4–5 (NKJV) <sup>4</sup> For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, <sup>5</sup> casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,
- These weapons are able to demolish every argument against the gospel. (1 Cor. 2:4–5; Heb 4:12)
- Neither the god of this Age nor his henchmen (11:15) can oppose the knowledge of God. (2 Cor. 4:4; 11:15)
- Can conquer & control every thought, bringing one to obedience in Christ — (Heb 4:12)


<sup>6</sup> and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.
