






- The "FAMILY," as God designed it, (Gen 2:18-24), is under attack
 - Radical feminism, LGBTQ advocates; radical individualism; men & women living together but not married; view of fornication & adultery, etc.
 - Divorce epidemic, broken homes, disconnected families, abuse, drugs, etc.



- *Families are comprised of imperfect people every family has challenges, problems, dilemmas, & changes that need to be overcome. . . .
- *When God comes first in the heart of every family member the family will be as God designed it!



- To return to God's purpose & guidance:
 - ❖ The Bible teaches there are distinctions in the roles of men and women - (1 Cor 14:34-37; 1 Tim 2:11-14)
 - Distinction in roles does not mean a distinction in value or importance (Gal 3:28; Ac 10:34; 2 Pet 3:9)
 - Women are JUST as valuable to God in fulfilling His purposes in the home, church, nation, humanity as men!



- To return to God's purpose & guidance:
 - Husband / Father Loves, Provides,
 Leads, & Trains (Eph 5:25,28; 1 Pet.
 3:7; Eph 6:4; 1 Tim. 5:8)
 - Wife / Mother Submits willingly to husband; Guides & keeps the house (Gen 3:16; Ep 5:22-24; 1 Pet. 3:1-6; Tit 2:4-5; 1 Tim 5:14; Prov 31)
 - Children Respect & obey their parents- (Eph. 6:1-4; 2 Tim. 3:1-5)

- God gave man the kind of companion he needed, i.e. - a "helper comparable to him."
- "I shall make a helper fit for him" (ESV); "I will make a suitable partner for him" (NAB); "suitable, corresponding to" (NASB).
- Woman completes man she is his equal in nature, & helper in function, (Genesis 1:26-27; 2:15-25).

1 TIMOTHY 2:9-15 (NKJV)


11 Let a woman learn in silence with all submission. 12 And I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man, but to be in silence. ¹³ For Adam was formed first, then Eve. 14 And Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived, fell into transgression. 15 Nevertheless she will be saved in childbearing if they continue in faith, love, and holiness, with self-control.




- Appearance: Modest apparel / with good works
 - with decency and propriety (cf. v. 15). These terms stress not so much the absence of sexual suggestiveness, though it is included, but rather an appearance that is simple, moderate, judicious, and free from ostentation.



- Appearance: Modest apparel / with good works
 - not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing, — are not wrong in themselves, but are inappropriate when they indicate misplaced values (cf. 1 Peter 3:3).
 - Christians must be careful about letting culture set their fashions.



- Not a requirement to "bear children" to be saved −
- ◆ Salvation comes by submitting to God's conditions & roles –
- The woman shall be saved by keeping simply and faithfully to her allotted sphere as wife and mother." -Dummelow



- **♦** If she Continues in
 - ➤ Faith the guiding principle in the life of a Christian—
 - Love Active GOOD WILL
 - ► Holiness Conduct befitting those separated to God 2 Cor 6:14-7:1
 - with self-control reign over all passions & desires

WHAT A GODLY WOMAN DOES



Titus 2:3-5 (NKJV)

³ the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things—4 that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children, ⁵ to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.



- ◆ As A Godly Mother
 - To love her children (Titus 2:4).
 - To provide for and cherish her children (1 Thes 2:7).
 - To teach her children the scriptures (2 Tim 1:5; 3:15)
 - To teach daughters & younger women how to be godly (Eze 16:44, I Tim 2:9-10).
 - ▶ To be honored (Eph 6:2)

THE GODLY WOMAN'S DISPOSITION



1 PETER 3:1-4 (NKJV)

¹ Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives, ² when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear.

THE GODLY WOMAN'S DISPOSITION



1 PETER 3:1-4 (NKJV)

³ Do not let your adornment be merely outward—arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel—4 rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God.



- Not a prohibition to the wearing of jewelry, makeup & (fine) clothing.
 - Not this But This specifying that which is precious in the sight of God Qualities that REALLY matter to Him and should be our focus!!



- ◆ Subjection is a role to be filled AND DOES NOT IMPLY INFERIORITY in value in the sight of God! - Eph 5:22,23
- ◆ Submission CANNOT be forced, but MUST BE voluntarily assumed!
- Culture CANNOT change God's designed roles - 1 Tim 2:9-15



- ✦ Holiness, Purity pure from carnality, disciplined.
- ◆ This purity results from the observance of God's Law – she is to live her every day life as God would have her live!
- Modest apparel, zealous in good works, sober minded ... teaching by example.



- Respect God by respecting His Word
- ◆ Respectful to all who are in a God appointed position -(1 Pet 3:6)
- ➤ Younger women should respect older, godly women by listening to them- Tit 2:4,5



- Meekness, "submitting to the yoke"
 disposition of spirit in which
 - we accept God's dealings with us as good.
- ★ The opposite of selfassertiveness & self-interest -we trust in God's goodness, control & will -
- Manifested in how we respond to others ...




- ◆ Quiet Tranquility in disposition. Peaceable.
- Not "SELF Assertive" Not a "busy body" −
- ◆ The opposite of "usurping authority"
- ◆ To be noticed for her godliness & service, not for self exaltation.




