

#### Luke 9:57-62 (NKJV)

57 Now it happened as they journeyed on the road, that someone said to Him, "Lord, I will follow You wherever You go." 58 And Jesus said to him, "Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to lay *His* head." 59 Then He said to another, "Follow Me." But he said, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father." 60 Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead, but you go and preach the kingdom of God." 61 And another also said, "Lord, I will follow You, but let me first go and bid them farewell who are at my house." 62 But Jesus said to him, "No one, having put his hand to the plow, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."



The difference between an EXCUSE and a REASON.

No excuse will be acceptable for NOT doing what we ought to do, or DOING what we shouldn't!


#### James 4:13–17 (NKJV)

13 Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, spend a year there, buy and sell, and make a profit"; 14 whereas you do not know what will happen tomorrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away. 15 Instead you *ought* to say, "If the Lord wills, we shall live and do this or that." 16 But now you boast in your arrogance. All such boasting is evil. 17 Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.

"Then the man said, 'The woman whom You gave to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I ate" (Gen. 3:12)

- Excuses are rationalizations we make to ourselves about people, events and circumstances.
- They are invented reasons we create to defend our behavior, to neglect taking a particular kind of action, or simply as a means of negating responsibility.
- Excuses are in essence a means of placing blame OF an internal problem ON an external condition.





# THERE IS NO EXCUSE for Our Excuses! The Reasons We Make Excuses

- Short on conviction (not convinced of the necessity ...)
- Lack confidence (question the reliability or effectiveness ...)
- Misplaced priorities & Values (not enough love ...)



- "Oh, my Lord, please send someone else." Ex. 4:13 (ESV)


The Reasons We Make Excuses



The REAL Problem Is A Matter of The WILL - "We Do Not Want To!" - (or at least we do not want to BAD ENOUGH!)



#### HEBREWS 12:1-4 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, 2 looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

HEBREWS 12:1-4 (NKJV) 3 For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls. 4 You have not yet resisted to bloodshed, striving against sin.
