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(Have We Sufficiently Destroyed Our Sinful Past?)

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11 Now when Peter had come to Antioch, I withstood him to his face, because he was to be blamed; 12 for before certain men came from James, he would eat with the Gentiles; but when they came, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing those who were of the circumcision. 13 And the rest of the Jews also played the hypocrite with him, so that even Barnabas was carried away with their hypocrisy.

¹⁴ But when I saw that they were not straightforward about the truth of the gospel, I said to Peter before them all, "If you, being a Jew, live in the manner of Gentiles and not as the Jews, why do you compel Gentiles to live as Jews? 15 We who are Jews by nature, and not sinners of the Gentiles, 16 knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ,

even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified. 17 "But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is Christ therefore a minister of sin? Certainly not! 18 For if I build again those things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.

19 For I through the law died to the law that I might live to God. 20 I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me. 21 I do not set aside the grace of God; for if righteousness comes through the law, then Christ died in vain."

18 For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you over weening, that they are the

even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: ¹⁹ whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame—who set their

mind on earthly things.

Romans 6:16–17 (NKJV)

16 Do you not know that to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey, whether of sin leading to death, or of obedience leading to righteousness? 17 But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered.

(Have We Sufficiently Destroyed Our Sinful Past?)

Galatians 2:17–18 (NKJV)

- "But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is Christ therefore a minister of sin? Certainly not! 18 For if I build again those things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.
 - ◆ We can, (and at times do), allow our OLD ways to return – thus we need to always be on guard! (Rom 16:19-22; 2 Pet 2:20-22)
 - ♦ We CANNOT follow Christ & sin at the same time — (1 John 1:5-9; 3:9)
 - ◆ Actions speak louder than words!

- ◆Peter Rebuilt Partiality (12)
 - ◆ He had learned better and taught against it!! – (Acts 10:9-16,28, 34,35; 15:7-11; Js 2:1-4)
 - ◆ He should have rebuked his Jewish brethren as Paul rebuked him – (Luk 17:3; Gal 2:4,5; 5:7-12)

- ◆Partiality Is SINFUL
 - ◆ Brotherly love makes NO
 DISTINCTION!! (Act 10:34;
 11:12; 15:9; Rom 2:11; 3:22;
 10:12; James 2:1-4; Gal 3:28,29)
 - ◆ Do our words and actions teach against this sin?

- ◆Rebuilt His Fear of Men (12)
 - ◆ "Fearing The Circumcision" (12)
 - Had heard Jesus teach "be not afraid of them that kill the body, – (Mat 10:28)
 - ◆ Peter asserted firm allegiance to Christ, defended Him in the garden, but then denied Jesus 3 times – (Luke 22:54-62)
 - ◆ Peter repented & previously manifested great boldness — (Act 4:8-12; 4:19).

 18 For if $^{oldsymbol{\otimes}}$ build again those things which $^{oldsymbol{\otimes}}$ destroyed, $^{oldsymbol{\otimes}}$ make myself a transgressor.

- ◆It takes courage to ...
 - ◆ Leave error and obey the gospel!!
 - ◆ Stand for the truth & oppose error!!
 - Preach the gospel to the lost!
 - ◆ Live for the Lord in an ungodly world!!
 - ◆ Oppose friends who practice error and who try to influence you to join them in unauthorized practices!!

 18 For if artildet build again those things which artildet destroyed, artildet make myself a transgressor.

- ◆ Rebuilt A Negative Influence (13)
 - ◆ Peter's problem was not what he truly believed, but what he practiced. He played the hypocrite! (Acts 11:3-13)
 - ◆ Barnabas & other Jews were "carried away" with this "hypocrisy." (13)
 - Barnabas was not a young Christian!! demonstrating the POWER of influence!

 18 For if $^{\odot}$ build again those things which $^{\odot}$ destroyed, $^{\odot}$ make myself a transgressor.

SOMEONE IS WATCHING YOU!

- ◆ We MUST ALWAYS be conscious of our influence (Mat. 5:13-16)
- ◆ This demonstrates the danger of following men – even normally good and respectable men!! (Gal. 1:6-9)
- What kind of influence are you having on those around you??

- ◆Peters actions were NOT in keeping with the Gospel! (14)
 - ◆ Gave credence and legitimacy to the Judaisers - (1-5; 15-18; Acts 15:2)
 - built again that which he had once destroyed - (Acts 15:7-11)
 - ◆ He had become a "TRANSGRESSOR!" (vs. 18; ls 59:1,2)

The Example of Paul ... Living By Faith In The Son of God

 20 Thave been crucified with Phrist; it is no longer T who live, but Phrist lives in me;

- ◆ Paul, through the Law died to the Law — (19; cf. 1:13-16; 3:10, 19-25; Rom 3:19,20; 7:4-6,10,11; 8:2-4; 10:4)
- ◆ Paul was crucified with Christ (20; 5:24; 6:14; Act 22:16; Rom 6:1-7; Col 2:11-14)
- ◆ Christ lived in Paul, (Paul no longer lived for himself!) — (20; cf. Col 3:1-17; Rom. 6:1-14)

 20 Thave been crucified with Phrist; it is no longer T who live, but Phrist lives in me;

- ◆ Have we "DIED" to lust, pride, error, etc. — Anything that is not according to Christ — Col. 2:20-3:11
- ◆ Have we been "crucified" with Christ? — (Rom 6:1-14; Col. 2:11-14)
- ◆ Does Christ "live in me?" John 14:21-23; 15:9,10; 1 Jn 2:3-6; 3:24

The Example of Paul ... Living By Faith In The Son of God

- ♦ We can live GODLY in this life (20; cf. Rom 6:1-19; 12:1,2; 1 Jn 2:6; 3:3; Titus 2:11-14; 1 Cor. 10:13; Ja 4:7-10)
- ♦ We can live by faith (2 Cor. 5:7; Heb 11:1-12:3; Rom 1:16,17; 10:17)
- ◆ Trusting in His grace, mercy, love & authority (Eph 2:1-10; Tit. 3:2-5; Rom 5:6-10; Act 2:36; Lk 6:46; 2 Jn 9)


