

Saul is chosen & anointed to be king over Israel — 1 Sam. 9; cf. 8:3-21

Two chapters in First Samuel stand out as turning points in the life of king Saul. 13 & 15




- Amalekites had previously attacked Israel in the wilderness - (Ex. 17:8-14)
- God promised to destroy the Amalekites when Israel had rest in Canaan – (Dt. 25:17-19)
- Saul was to carry out God's vengeance against them (1 Sam 15:1-3).



# I Samuel 15

- Saul defeats Amelek (1 Sam. 15:4-7)
- Saul proved disobedient- (1 Sam. 15:8-9).
- Saul deposed by God (1 Sam. 15:10,11,23)
- Samuel confronts Saul for his rebellion against God
   - (1 Sam. 15:12-31).
- Samuel kills Agag by hacking him to pieces -(1 Sam. 15:32-33).



### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin



- DENIAL Saul acted as if he had not sinned:
  - > "Blessed are you of the Lord" {15:13}
  - "I have performed the commandment of the Lord" {15:13}
  - "I have obeyed the voice of the Lord, and gone on the mission on which the Lord sent me, ... I have utterly destroyed the Amalekites. {15:20}

### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin

■ DENIAL - Saul acted as if he had not sinned:

Prov 28:13 <sup>13</sup> "He who covers his sins will not prosper, But whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will have mercy."—

1 John 1:8–10 <sup>8</sup> "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." —

### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin



- They have brought them from the Amalekites; for the people spared the best of the sheep and the oxen,"—{15:15}
- But the people took of the plunder, sheep and oxen, the best of the things which should have been utterly destroyed" [15:21]
- "I have transgressed the commandment of the Lord and your words, because I feared the people and obeyed their voice"—{15:24}

### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin




# I WILL BE HELD ACCOUNTABLE FOR MY OWN ACTIONS - (cf Gen 3:12,13)

Eze 18:20 <sup>20</sup> The soul who sins shall die. ... The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself.

Rom 2:6–11 <sup>6</sup> who "will render to each one according to his deeds": ... <sup>11</sup> For there is no partiality with God.

Gal 6:7 <sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.




### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin



- PRAGMATISM Saul claimed his purposes were good:
  - "and brought back Agag king of Amalek;" [15:20]
  - "in order to sacrifice them to the LORD your God at Gilgal." [Sam 15:21]
- The end does NOT justify the means (cf Rom 3:8; 1 Sam 15:21-23)

### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin



#### 1 Samuel 15:22-23 (NKJV)


<sup>22</sup> So Samuel said: "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams. 23 For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, And stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, He also has rejected you from being king."

### Wrong Ways To Deal With Sin



- Selective Comparisons 2 Cor 10:12
- Claim ignorance Acts 17:11; 2 Tim 2:15; Acts 17:30
- Claim moderation Eph 5:3-7; 1 Thes 5:22; Heb 2:1-3
- I'm the victim 1 Pet 2:18-23
- Procrastination Acts 24:25; Rom 2:4

### The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



#### Psalm 38:3-5 (NKJV)

3 There is no soundness in my flesh Because of Your anger, Nor any health in my bones Because of my sin. 4 For my iniquities have gone over my head; Like a heavy burden they are too heavy for me. 5 My wounds are foul and festering Because of my foolishness.


### The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



#### Psalm 51:1-4 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Have mercy upon me, O God, According to Your lovingkindness; According to the multitude of Your tender mercies, Blot out my transgressions. 2 Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, And cleanse me from my sin. <sup>3</sup> For I acknowledge my transgressions, And my sin is always before me. 4 Against You, You only, have I sinned, And done this evil in Your sight—That You may be found just when You speak, And blameless when You judge.

# The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



- Our conversion is really an execution- (Rom. 6:3-6).
- Baptism does not end our conflict with sin (Acts 2:38-42; Rom. 6:3-23; I Cor. 6:9-11; Gal. 5:16-21).
- God commands us to CONTINUE to put sin to death (Mat. 5:29,30; Rom. 6; 8:12,13; Gal. 5:24; Col. 3:5-8).

## The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin

#### Romans 6:1-23 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? <sup>2</sup> Certainly not! How shall we who died to sin live any longer in it? <sup>3</sup> Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? 4 Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. <sup>5</sup> For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the likeness of His resurrection,

## The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin

#### Romans 6:1-23 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> knowing this, that our old man was crucified with *Him*, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. <sup>7</sup> For he who has died has been freed from sin. <sup>8</sup> Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, <sup>9</sup> knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him. <sup>10</sup> For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God. 11 Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

### The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin

#### Romans 6:1-23 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. <sup>13</sup> And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God. <sup>14</sup> For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace. 15 What then? Shall we sin because we are not under law but under grace? Certainly not!

## The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin

#### Colossians 3:5-9 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. <sup>6</sup> Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, <sup>7</sup> in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them. <sup>8</sup> But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds,

# The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



- Sin MUST be dealt with
  - > By the Spirit (through the gospel) Romans 8:13; cf. Rom 7:5-8:12
  - > Put on the Lord Jesus Christ Rom. 13:14
  - Stop lusting 1 Pet. 2:11; Gal. 5:16; Rom 13:14

### The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin

### Romans 13:11-14 (NKJV)

11 And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is nearer than when we first believed. 12 The night is far spent, the day is at hand. Therefore let us cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armor of light. 13 Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy. 14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

# The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



#### Sin MUST be dealt with

- With God's help & provisions — {Eph. 6:10-18; Jam 4:6-10; 2 Pet. 1:5-10}
- > Ruthlessly [Mat. 5:29,30; 18:8,9; Rom 13:13,14]
- Completely / fully [2 Cor. 10:5; Eph. 6:16; Heb 12:1]
- Quickly [1 Cor. 6:18; 1 Thes. 5:22; 2 Cor. 6:2; Rom. 13:11,12]

### The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



- Recognize how horrible sin is to a "holy, holy, holy" God. (Hab. 1:13; 1 Pet. 1:15,16)
- Be led by the Spirit (Rom. 8:12-14; [vss. 1-8]; Gal 5:16).
- Draw closer to the Lord (Rom 13:14; Col. 3:10-12; Tit. 2:14; 3:14).
- Do whatever it takes to avoid sin
   (Rom. 13:14; Matt. 5:27-30; 1
  Pet. 2:11; 1 Cor. 10:13)

### The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



- This battle between us and sin will never end, but the key is that we actively engage in combat, not denying our sins but confessing them (1 John 1:8-9).
  - But if you do not commit yourself to merciless combat against sin, some day, like Saul, it will come back to haunt and destroy you.

# The ONLY Way To Deal W/ Sin



The proper way for God's people to deal with their sins and receive forgiveness is to confess these sins, repent, and pray to God for forgiveness (1 John 1:9; Acts 8:22).
