

 what we do -








Enemy - Persecutor


♦ A Pharisee - Acts 23:6

Very Religious






Before Mis Conversion

- Acts 23:1 I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day
- Acts 24:16 I myself always strive to have a conscience without offense toward God and men.
- Acts 26:9 Indeed, I myself thought I must do many things contrary to the name of Jesus of Nazareth.

Not Saved On The Road

- → Saved before being told what he must do? (Acts 9:6; 22:10)
- Saved but still miserable??? -(Acts 9:9,11)
- Saved but still in his sins??? -(Acts 22:16)
- ◆ Saved without calling on the name of the Lord? - (Acts 22:16)



Saul's Conversion




Jesus Sent A Preacher

- Ananias told Saul what he MUST do Acts 9:10-19
 - Not to pray or ask Jesus into his heart . . . (Acts 9:11; 22:16)
 - Believed in Christ (John 8:24)
 - Repented (Acts 17:30-31)
 - He was told to be baptized, calling on the name of the Lord (Acts 22:16)



Saul After His Conversion




A Sincere, Devoted, Loyal Disciple


A Sincere, Devoted, Loyal Disciple

Acts 26:19-21 (NKJV)

²⁰ but declared first to those in Damascus and in Jerusalem, and throughout all the region of Judea, and *then* to the Gentiles, that they should repent, turn to God, and do works befitting repentance. ²¹ For these reasons the Jews seized me in the temple and tried to kill *me*.

1 Corinthians 15:9-10 (NKJV) ⁹ For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. 10 But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all, yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.




2 Corinthians 11:23-28 (NKJV)

²³ Are they ministers of Christ?--I speak as a fool--I *am* more: in labors more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequently, in deaths often. 24 From the Jews five times I received forty stripes minus one. 25 Three times I was beaten with rods; once I was stoned; three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I have been in the deep; 26 in journeys often, in perils of waters, in perils of robbers, in perils of my own countrymen, in perils of the Gentiles, in perils in the city, in perils in the wilderness, in perils in the sea, in perils among false brethren; 27 in weariness and toil, in sleeplessness often, in hunger and thirst, in fastings often, in cold and nakedness-- ²⁸ besides the other things, what comes upon me daily: my deep concern for all the churches.





♦ Not saved because taught by popular teachers


Not saved just because religious and sincere

Not saved by faith only




Lessons & Applications
