


A study of The Law Two Major Divisions

Love God

- 1. You shall have no other gods before Me.
 - 2. You shall not make for yourself a carved image.
- 3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- 4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

Love Man

- 5. Honor your father and your mother.
 - 6. You shall not murder.
 - 7. You shall not commit adultery.
 - 8. You shall not steal.
 - 9. You shall not bear false witness.
 - 10. You shall not covet.


Honor <H3513> פבד פבד ,kâbad, kâbêd




- ★ Ex 21:15 And he who strikes his father or his mother shall surely be put to death.

"Honor your father and your mother,"

Deuteronomy 21:18-21 (NKJV)

18 "If a man has a stubborn and rebellious son who will not obey the voice of his father or the voice of his mother, and who, when they have chastened him, will not heed them, 19 then his father and his mother shall take hold of him and bring him out to the elders of his city, to the gate of his city. 20 And they shall say to the elders of his city, 'This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious; he will not obey our voice; he is a glutton and a drunkard.' 21 Then all the men of his city shall stone him to death with stones; so you shall put away the evil from among you, and all Israel shall hear and fear.



- Given to the children of Israel to insure their long life in the land of promise -
- This command is also a part of the New Covenant -

¹⁸ Wives, submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord. 19 Husbands, love your wives and do not be bitter toward them. 20 Children, obey your parents in all things, for this is well pleasing to the Lord. 21 Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged. ²² Bondservants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh, not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but in sincerity of heart, fearing God.

Obstacles To Filial Piety:

- Parents overreaction to their upbringing (communication, discipline, things...)
- ♦ Worldly media –
- Busy parents –
- The pursuit of academic excellence rather than moral and spiritual excellence -

It Does Not Mean:

- Honor only if the person is personally perceived as deserving
- Honor only if the person always reciprocates
- Honor only if it is pleasing to you to do so
- Honor only if you get compliments for doing so
- ✦ Honor only if it "feels right"
- ✦ Honor only if other people also do so."

- → By trying to please them.
- → By forgiving their failures.

- → By affirming their effort.
- → By listening to their advice.

- ◆ By taking care of them when they are older and disabled. - Leviticus 19:32; Matt. 15:1-9



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
