#### 1 CORINTHIANS 3:1-23 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup>And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ. <sup>2</sup> I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able; <sup>3</sup> for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men? <sup>4</sup> For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another, "I am of Apollos," are you not carnal?

#### 1 CORINTHIANS 3:1-23 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Who then is Paul, and who *is* Apollos, but ministers through whom you believed, as the Lord gave to each one? <sup>6</sup> I planted, Apollos watered, but God gave the increase. <sup>7</sup> So then neither he who plants is anything, nor he who waters, but God who gives the increase. <sup>8</sup> Now he who plants and he who waters are one, and each one will receive his own reward according to his own labor. <sup>9</sup> For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building.

<sup>10</sup> According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. 1 Corinthians 3:5
(NKJV)
5 Who then is Paul,
and who is Apollos,
but ministers
through whom you
believed, as the Lord
gave to each one?

- ★ Who was Paul and Apollos? (5; 1:10-12; 4:1,2; 2 Cor. 4:5-7)
- ◆ God works through the word (5,6; Rom. 10:14-17; 2 Thes. 2:13,14)
- ★ The unity of those who preach the truth – (They preach the same gospel – working in the same field they were building on the same foundation – 8,9; 1 Cor 4:17; 12:13; Eph. 2:19-22; 4:1-6,11-16)


# God's Building The Danger of Defiling God's Building - (3:16,17)

1 Corinthians 3:17
(NKJV)

17 If anyone defiles
the temple of God,
God will destroy
him. For the temple
of God is holy, which
temple you are.

- ★ The temple is the church, i.e. God's building (16,17; 9; Eph. 2:19-22; 1 Pet. 2:4-10)
- ◆ Those causing schisms in the church at Corinth were guilty of defiling the temple – (17;

1:10-12; 3:1-4; 5:1-8; 11:17-21; 14:21; 15:12)



#### 1 Corinthians 3:18-23 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. <sup>19</sup> For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their own craftiness"; (Job 5:13)
