

It is essential, therefore, that believers have a firm foundation in Scripture relating to this teaching. (2 John 1:7)

- Interpretations of Jesus are fraught with bias.
 - Gnostics Deity & flesh are incompatible -
 - Unitarianism, Modalism, Arianism - The concept that "God is one excludes the possibility of the Son being God."
- The biblical teaching about Jesus constitutes a powerful cumulative case regarding Jesus as our Lord and God. (Titus 2:13)

- Jesus exposes their hypocrisy by quoting Psalm 82:6 John 10:34
- How could they deny that the scripture refers to human judges as "gods?" Therefore, how could they justify their actions seeing that the works of Christ 'backed up' His claim to be the Son of God? John 10:35-38
 - "The Father is in Me and I in Him" John 10:38


Names: Jesus shares the names / descriptions of God.



- The phrase "The Son of Man" identified Jesus as an equal partaker of humanity! (Mat 8:20 [29 times])
- The phrase "The Son of God" identified Jesus as an equal partaker of Deity (Phili 2:6; Heb 1:3; Col 1:15)
- Neither phrase has reference to Jesus' age, birth or genesis but rather the extent of the relationship He had with both humanity & Deity cf. John 8:44

Titus 2:13 - "We have Granville Sharp's rule here, which says that when there are two nouns in the same case connected by kai $(\kappa\alpha)$ (and), the first noun having the article, the second noun not having the article, the second noun refers to the same thing the first noun does and is a further description of it. . . . "the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ." Both expressions refer to the same individual. The deity of the Lord Jesus is brought out here by a rule of Greek syntax. The pronoun "our" is polemic... the Christian's God and Saviour is Jesus Christ.



"The great God and our Saviour Jesus"—There is but one Greek article to "God" and "Saviour," which shows that both are predicated of one and the same Being. "Of Him who is at once the great God and our Saviour." Also (2) "appearing" (epiphaneia) is never by Paul predicated of God the Father (Jn 1:18; 1Ti 6:16), or even of "His glory" (as Alford explains it): ... the expression "great God," as applied to Christ, ... just as "the true God" is predicated of Christ, 1Jn 5:20.... Jamieson, R., Fausset, A. R., & Brown, D. (1997). Commentary Critical and Explanatory on the Whole Bible. Oak Harbor, WA: Logos Research Systems, Inc.


If Jesus Is Not Deity


If Jesus Is Deity

Real atonement / A sacrifice demonstrating both the love & justice of God - A sacrifice worthy of taking away the sins of the world - Rom 5:8-10; 1 John 2:1,2

Jesus is qualified to be our one and only mediator / capable of equally representing both parties - 1 Tim 2:5; theb 8:6; 9:15; 12:24

Jesus is the only way to the Father - "Except you believe that I am the you will die in your sins" - John 14:6; 8:24; 10:9; Acts 4:12
