


- ◆Those who love riches will weep & howl in misery (1)

# Therefore Be Patient

A Warning To The Wealthy

James 5:5,6 (NKJV) 5 You have lived on the earth in pleasure and luxury; you have fattened your hearts as in a day of slaughter. <sup>6</sup> You have condemned, you have murdered the just; he does not resist you.

- ◆They were well aware of God's Law forbidding holding back on wages (Lev. 19:13; Deut. 24:15) and oppressing the poor (Prov. 3:27-28; Amos 8:4-6; Mal. 3:5).
- ◆The rich used their influence and power to condemn innocent men who offered no resistance (James 2:6; cf. Ahab -1 Kings 21:1-15)





"Longsuffering is that quality of self-restraint in the face of provocation which does not hastily retaliate or promptly punish; it is the opposite of anger, and is associated with mercy, and is used of God, Exod. 34:6 (Sept.); Rom. 2:4; 1 Pet. 3:20.






- ◆ "Patience is waiting. Not passively waiting. That is laziness. But to keep going when the going is hard and slow - that is patience." -(Author Unknown)


#### Psalms 37:7 (NKJV)

Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.




#### Luke 8:15 (NKJV)

on the good ground are those who, having heard the word with a noble and good heart, keep it and bear fruit with patience.




#### Romans 2:6-7 (NKJV)

- ↑ The need for continuance (vs. 7; Rom. 2:7; Heb. 6:11,12; Rev. 2:10)
- ★ Example of the farmer (vs. 7; Dependence upon God's provisions – Hos. 6:3; Joel 2:23)
- ★ Establish your hearts (vs. 8; Ps 27:14; 28:7; 112:7,8; Prov. 3:5; 4:23)
- ◆ Do not complain and grumble (vs. 9; 1 Cor. 10:10;1 Pet. 4:9)

### "Therefore Be Patient Brethren"

- Consider the prophets and their end (vs. 10, 11a; Acts 7:52; Heb. 11:32-12:3; Mat. 5:10,11; 10:22)
- Consider the perseverance of Job and the end intended by God – (vs. 11; Job 23:10; 42:10-17; Eccl. 7:8; 1 Pet. 1:6,7; 2 Pet. 2:9)
- Consider our lack of control (vs. 12; 4:13-17; Mat. 5:33-37; 6:25-34)

#### Some Negative Consequences Of Impatience



- Run the risk of always being dissatisfied, upset, and angry with ourselves -
- ◆ Easily lose our control and fire off outbursts of anger, temper, and blame on others.
- ★ We become a member of the "throw away" generation, discarding relationships, people, jobs, school, churches etc.
- ★ We waste energy worrying about how slow things are changing instead of directing the energy toward the changes we desire.

### Some Negative Consequences Of Impatience




- ♦ We withdraw prematurely from a helping situation because we are not seeing an immediate pay off for our efforts.
- ♦ We sacrifice friendships and relationships prematurely because the other person is not changing as quickly or as thoroughly as we desire.
- ♦ We ignore all of the positive gains we and others have made on the road to recovery and growth, only concentrating on what has not yet been accomplished.

#### Some Negative Consequences Of Impatience



- We become pessimistic about life and neglect to count our blessings.
- ◆ Wanting to see certain results now, we burn ourselves out – and neglect other important things, and become discouraged when the goals are not instantly realized.
- ♦ We lose the ability to take a large goal and break it down into manageable increments.
- ★ We become overwhelmed by the large tasks ahead of us and lose the hope and motivation to keep on trying.
