#### Matthew 7:1-6 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> "Judge not, that you be not judged. <sup>2</sup> For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you. <sup>3</sup> And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye? 4 Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me remove the speck from your eye'; and look, a plank is in your own eye?

# Judgment Without Mercy

#### Matthew 7:1-6 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye. <sup>6</sup> Do not give what is holy to the dogs; nor cast your pearls before swine, lest they trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you in pieces.




### Not Forbidding All Types of Judgment

#### Nature of The Judgment "Forbidden"

The Model

Luke 6:35-45 (NKJV)

35 But love your enemies, do good, and lend, hoping for nothing in return; and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High. For He is kind to the unthankful and evil. 36 Therefore be merciful, just as your Father also is merciful. 37 "Judge not, and you shall not be judged. Condemn not, and you shall not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven.

Do not consider another insignificant or unworthy of mercy – Do not seek the destruction of another – seek reconciliation – The same method you use will come back to you!

#### Luke 6:35-45 (NKJV)

<sup>38</sup> Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you." <sup>39</sup> And He spoke a parable to them: "Can the blind lead the blind? Will they not both fall into the ditch?

<sup>40</sup> A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone who is perfectly trained will be like his teacher. <sup>41</sup> And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the plank in your own eye? <sup>42</sup> Or how can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove the speck that *is* in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the plank that *is* in your own eye?




# We Bring Condemnation Upon Ourselves

  - If we condemn others while we ourselves harbor sin in our hearts -
- If we are unmerciful in our dealings with others -

#### "Why Do You Look?"

- → Because of our iniquity Mat. 7:3; Rom. 2:1-3;
- Because of our self righteousnessLuke 18:9-14; 2 Cor. 10:12
- ▶ Because of our ignorance 1 Cor. 4:3-5; Prov. 18:13; Rom. 14
- ▶ Because of our insensitivity Luke 19:10; Rom. 9:1-3; 10:1-3

#### What Is This Text Teaching Us?



Hypocrite! First remove the plank from your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.

- → We must engage in honest& Serious introspection –2 Cor. 13:5
- ◆ Correcting our own sinful actions and attitudes so we can effectively help others
   Gal. 6:1-3
- ♦ We need Sufficient humility to deal patiently with others – Titus 3:2,3


Wicked Men To Be Identified Romans 16:17-18 (NKJV)

## Wise Discrimination Essential


Scriptures Require That We Distinguish Between Right & Wrong, Truth & Error, Good & Evil . . .



- We live in a culture in which many hate moral & theological absolutes (2 Tim. 4:2-4; 2 Jn 3:13)
- We live in a culture in which the only absolute wrong is to stand up and say – "This is WRONG?"
- ▶ It is NOT unloving to call sin SIN it is unloving NOT to!

#### **Leviticus 19:17-18 (NKJV)**

<sup>17</sup> 'You shall not hate your brother in your heart. You shall surely rebuke your neighbor, and not bear sin because of him. <sup>18</sup> You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I *am* the LORD.


Not By Appearance, But Righteousness

#### John 7:21-24 (NKJV)

<sup>24</sup> Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment."




#### Acts 17:11 (NKJV)

→ Do you always watch for those who will be receptive


