

NEHEMIAH 8:1-12




- ◆ The walls of Jerusalem have been completed and the people have returned to settle in their homeland – Neh. 1:1-7:73
- ◆ It was the seventh month, (Tishri Sept. Oct.), the Feast of Trumpets began the month of festivals- (Lev. 23:24; Num. 29:1), the 10th day was the day of atonement, (Lev. 16: 23:26-32), the 15th-21st was the Feast of Tabernacles, (Lev. 23:33-36).



- ◆ The priesthood and sacrificial system had been restored at an earlier time, (Ezra 3:1-13),
- ★ The time had come for the Law of God to be read before the people so that their worship and lives may be restored to God's prescribed order, (Nehemiah 8:1-12)

Nehemiah 8:1-12 (NKJV) ¹ Now all the people gathered together as one man in the open square that was in front of the Water Gate; and they told Ezra the scribe to bring the Book of the Law of Moses, which the LORD had commanded Israel. ² So Ezra the priest brought the Law before the assembly of men and women and all who could hear with understanding on the first day of the seventh month.



Nehemiah 8:1-12 (NKJV) ⁴ So Ezra the scribe stood on a platform of wood which they had made for the purpose; and beside him, at his right hand, stood Mattithiah, Shema, Anaiah, Urijah, Hilkiah, and Maaseiah; and at his left hand Pedaiah, Mishael, Malchijah, Hashum, Hashbadana, Zechariah, and Meshullam.

Nehemiah 8:1-12 (NKJV) ⁵ And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people, for he was standing above all the people; and when he opened it, all the people stood up. ⁶ And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. Then all the people answered, "Amen, Amen!" while lifting up their hands. And they bowed their heads and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground.


Nehemiah 8:1-12 (NKJV) ⁷ Also Jeshua, Bani, Sherebiah, Jamin, Akkub, Shabbethai, Hodijah, Maaseiah, Kelita, Azariah, Jozabad, Hanan, Pelaiah, and the Levites, helped the people to understand the Law; and the people stood in their place. 8 So they read distinctly from the book, in the Law of God; and they gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading.

Nehemiah 8:1-12 (NKJV) ⁹ And Nehemiah, who was the governor, Ezra the priest and scribe, and the Levites who taught the people said to all the people, "This day is holy to the LORD your God; do not mourn nor weep." For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the Law. 10 Then he said to them, "Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared;


Nehemiah 8:1-12 (NKJV) for this day is holy to our LORD. Do not sorrow, for the joy of the LORD is your strength." 11 So the Levites quieted all the people, saying, "Be still, for the day is holy; do not be grieved." 12 And all the people went their way to eat and drink, to send portions and rejoice greatly, because they understood the words that were declared to them.




- → To worship & hear God's word - Acts 4:23-31; 20:7,8; 1 Cor. 11:33




→ They assembled with a united purpose, to learn what God had revealed to them so they could obey and be pleasing to Him - 8:1





God's Word Their Time & Attention – 8:1

- ★ Literally . . "From the light" (about 6 hours, Keil & Delitzsch commentary)
- ◆ The law was read each day of the seven day feast (vs. 18)

- → Bible classes (Attendance, preparation, attentiveness)
- → Preaching (Listening, following in Bible, taking notes)
- → Personal Bible reading and study - (Daily, habitual meditation, cross references)

- ♦ Needed to grow 1 Pet 2:2
- Needed for us to teach others - Heb. 5:12,13
- ♦ Needed for us to discern **good & evil** – Heb. 5:14








→ A planned event that the people prepared for -(They were prepared to hear, learn



They Gave It Respect


[5] . . . when he opened it, all the people stood up.



- → When Ezra opened the scroll the people stood
- → Responded to Ezra's praising God by saying "Amen" - raising their hands and bowing themselves . . .
- → Remained in their place as the Law was explained . .

They Gave It Respect

- → The position of our hearts and minds . . .
- → In our participation in the worship - (worship is not a spectator event)
- → Remaining in our place, listening carefully and participating enthusiastically . . .

(Psalm 89:7)


• God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, And to be held in reverence by all *those* around Him.

• Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.





⁸ 'These people draw near to Me with their mouth, And honor Me with their lips, But their heart is far from Me.


⁹ And in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.'"

- → They read distinctly from the book, in the Law of God - (8) -
- \rightarrow They gave the sense, (8) (explained the meaning)
- → Therefore the people were able to understand the Law - (9b, 12b)


[12] ... they understood the words that were declared to them.



→ People need to know what the scriptures say -(2 Tim 4:2; 1 Pet. 4:11)

Good preaching and teaching explains what the scriptures mean -(Luke 24:27; 2 Tim 2:15; 2 Pet. 3:15-18)

[12] ... they understood the words that were declared to them.



→ Too many today use pulpits to entertain, tell jokes, tell stories, and focus more on social ills than actually teaching the word of God -

→ Consequently, too many remain untaught about what the Bible actually teaches.


[12] ... they understood the words that were declared to them.



- → False teachers prey on the uneducated - (Eph. 4:14; 2 Pet 2:18; 3:16-18
- → It takes longer to clean up a mess than starting from scratch . . .

They Obeyed It


[9] . . . For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the Law



- ★ They did as they were instructed (10-12)
- ★ They repented and corrected not keeping the feast days (Neh. 8:13-17).
- → Put away their pagan wives - (Neh. 13:1-3).

James 1:21-25 (NKJV)

²¹Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. 22 But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. ²³ For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in a mirror; ²⁴ for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. ²⁵ But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does.



- ◆Do we hunger for it?
- ◆Do we prepare ourselves to receive it?
