

To arrive at a verbal formula – the prepositions "In" or "into" (Epi, Eis, En) Must MEAN pronouncement!

The Prepositions "In" or "Into" - 4 (Epi, Eis, En)

Where is the passage demanding pronouncement?

To arrive at a verbal formula – the prepositions "In" or "into" (Epi, Eis, En) Must MEAN pronouncement!

1722 en en en - a primary preposition denoting (fixed) position (in place, time or state), and (by implication) instrumentality (medially or constructively), i.e. a relation of rest (intermediate between 1519 and 1537); TDNT-2:537,233; prep - AV-in 1902, by 163, with 140, among 117, at 113, on 62, through 39, misc 265; 2801 1) in, by, with etc.


Acts 2:38 . . . "upon (epi) the name of Christ," to do anything, relying upon the name, i.e. authority of anyone.

THAYER, PAGE 447

Acts 8:16, 19:5 . . . "in (eis) the name of the Lord Jesus" - To do a thing, i.e., by ones command and authority, acting on His behalf, promoting His cause.


Acts 10:48 . . . "in (en) the name of the Lord" . . . of his own free-will and authority, John 5:43; to do a thing εν τω ονοματι "of Jesus," Acts 10:48" . . .

these passages give the
authority for the act, not the
formula that was employed.


Word Pictures in the New Testament.



In the name of Jesus Christ

The use of onoma means in the name or with the authority of one as eis onoma prophētou (Matthew 10:41) as a prophet, in the name of a prophet. In the Acts the full name of the Trinity does not occur in baptism as in Matthew 28:19, but this does not show that it was not used.

Matthew 28:18-20 (NKJV)

¹⁸ And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." Amen.

(Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:46-48).

Mark 16:15-16 (NKJV)

¹⁵ And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

¹⁶ He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

(Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:15-16; Luke 24:46-48).

⁴⁶ Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, ⁴⁷ and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

BAPTIZED INTO (EIV EIS)?

—Vincent's Word Studies in the New Testament

In the name (εἰς τὸ ὄνομα)

"Rev., correctly, "into the name." Baptizing into the name has a twofold meaning. 1. Unto, denoting object or purpose, as εἰς μετάνοιαν, unto repentance (Matthew 3:11); εἰς ἄφεσιν αμαρτιῶν, for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). 2. Into, denotingunion or communion with, as Romans 6:3, "baptized into Christ Jesus; into his death;" i.e., we are brought by baptism into fellowship with his death. Baptizing into the name of the Holy Trinity implies a spiritual and mystical union with him. Εἰς, into, is the preposition commonly used with baptize. See Acts 8:16; 19:3, 5; 1 Corinthians 1:13, 15; 10:2; Galatians 3:27."

BAPTIZED INTO (EIV EIS)?

—Vincent's Word Studies in the New Testament

In the name (εἰς τὸ ὄνομα)

"In Acts 2:38, however, Peter says, "Be baptized upon $(\dot{\epsilon}\pi\dot{\iota})$ the name of Jesus Christ; and in Acts 10:48, he commands Cornelius and his friends to be baptized in ($\dot{\epsilon}\nu$) the name of the Lord . . . The name, as in the Lord's Prayer ("Hallowed be thy name"), is the expression of the sum total of the divine Being: not his designation as God or Lord, but the formula in which all his attributes and characteristics are summed up. It is equivalent to his person . . . When one is baptized into the name of the Trinity, he professes to acknowledge and appropriate God in all that he is and in all that he does for man . . ."





ONE MUST REPENT IN THE NAME OF JESUS



The copulative conjunction "and" couples two verbs. The phrase "in the name of Jesus Christ" modifies both verbs, sustaining equal relation to both.

ONE MUST REPENT IN THE NAME OF JESUS



Must the baptizer say "I REPENT YOU IN THE NAME OF JESUS?"

WHAT WERE THEY TAUGHT?

- → Jesus was approved by God . . . [22]
- → **Jesus** did miracles by the power of God . . . [22]
- → Jesus was crucified according to the foreknowledge of God . . . [23]
- → **Jesus** was raised from the dead by God . . . [24, 32]
- → **Jesus'** soul was not left in hell nor did God allow His Holy One to see corruption . . . [27,31]
- → **Jesus** was raised to sit on His throne as God had promised [30]
- → Jesus was exalted to the right hand of God ... [33,34]
- → **Jesus** received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost . . . [33]
- → **Jesus,** who is Lord, was told by His Lord to sit at His right hand . . . [34]
- → Jesus was made both Lord and Christ by God, (the Father) ... [36]

WHAT WERE THEY TAUGHT?

[37] Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and brethren, what shall we do?

[38] Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.



What The Sinner Was To Do (Epi, Eis, En)

Acts 2:38 (NKJV)

³⁸Then Peter said to them,
"Repent, and let every one
of you be baptized in [*epi*]
the name of Jesus Christ for
the remission of sins; and
you shall receive the gift of
the Holy Spirit.

- ◆ Baptism "in (upon) the name of Jesus Christ" does not rest upon His designation – but upon His person.
- ◆ To be baptized "in (upon) the name of Jesus Christ"
 means that in baptism the sinner recognizes the sacrifice and exaltation of Christ as the ground of his salvation.

WHAT THE SINNER WAS TO DO (Epi, Eis, En)

Acts 8:16 (NKJV)

¹⁶ For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in [eis] the name of the Lord Jesus.

- **♦** When the sinner was baptized he placed his confidence in the sacrifice and Lordship of the Son of God.
- **♦**INTO union and communion with the one Who died -(Rom. 6:3-6)

What The Sinner Was To Do ² (Epi, Eis, En)

Acts 10:48 (NKJV) 48 And he commanded

them to be baptized in [en] the name of the Lord. Then they asked him to stay a few days.

- ◆The command had force or power due to the authority residing in Christ.
- ◆ Baptism "In (Év) the name of the Lord" means one is baptized in recognition of the commandment of the Son of God.

Not A Uniform Verbal Formula But Authorized Action

Acts 2:38 (KJV) Then Peter said unto them,
Repent, and be baptized every one of you in
the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of
sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy
Ghost.

Acts 8:16 (KJV) (For as yet he was fallen upon none of them: only they were baptized <u>in the name of the Lord Jesus</u>.)

Acts 10:48 (KJV) And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.

Acts 19:5 (KJV) When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Colossians 3:17 (NKJV)

¹⁷ And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.

Not a verbal formula but authorized action!

"In The Name Of The Lord Jesus"

Col. 3:17 - Authorized Action

"Do all in the name of the Lord Jesus"

- → "Seek those things which are above" (verse 1).
- → "Set your mind on things above" (verse 2).
- → "Put to death your members" (verse 5).
- → "Put off all these" (verse 8).
- → "Do not lie to one another" (verse 9).
- → "Put on tender mercies" (verse 12).
- → "Bearing with one another, and forgiving" (verse 13).
- → "Put on love" (verse 14).
- ◆ "Let the peace of God rule . . . and be thankful" (verse 15).
- → "Let the word of Christ dwell in you" (verse 16).

"In The Name Of" Doesn't Require 33 VERBAL PRONOUNCEMENT!

WAS TABITHA RAISED IN THE NAME OF JESUS?

Acts 9:36-40 (NKJV) ... 40 But Peter put them all out, and knelt down and prayed. And turning to the body he said, "Tabitha, arise." And she opened her eyes, and when she saw Peter she sat up.

Calling On The Name Of The Lord 34

(Not what the Preacher Says)

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in

Calling on the name of the Lord is invoking the Lord's blessing by doing what He says

Acts 22:16 (NKJV)

¹⁶ And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.'

Calling On The Name Of The Lord 35

(Not what the Preacher Says)

APPEAL

- Usage Number: 1 Strong's Number: <G1941>
 - ἐπικαλέω, epikaleō

"to call upon," has the meaning "appeal" in the Middle Voice, which carries with it the suggestion of a special interest on the part of the doer of an action in that in which he is engaged. Stephen died "calling upon the Lord," Acts 7:59. In the more strictly legal sense the word is used only of Paul's "appeal" to Caesar, Acts 25:11, 12, 21, 25; Acts 26:32; Acts 28:19.


