¹³ Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. ¹⁴

Judgment Day Surprises

Acts 17:30-31 (NKJV)

³⁰ Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent, ³¹ because He has appointed a day on which He will judge the world in righteousness by the Man whom He has ordained. He has given assurance of this to all by raising Him from the dead."

Judgment Day Surprises

Romans 2:5-11 (NKJV)

⁵ But in accordance with your hardness and your impenitent heart you are treasuring up for yourself wrath in the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God, ⁶ who "*will render to each one according to his deeds*": ⁷ eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality;

Judgment Day Surprises

Romans 2:5-11 (NKJV)

⁸ but to those who are self-seeking and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness-- indignation and wrath, ⁹ tribulation and anguish, on every soul of man who does evil, of the Jew first and also of the Greek; ¹⁰ but glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. ¹¹ For there is no partiality with God.

2 Corinthians 5:9-11 (NKJV)

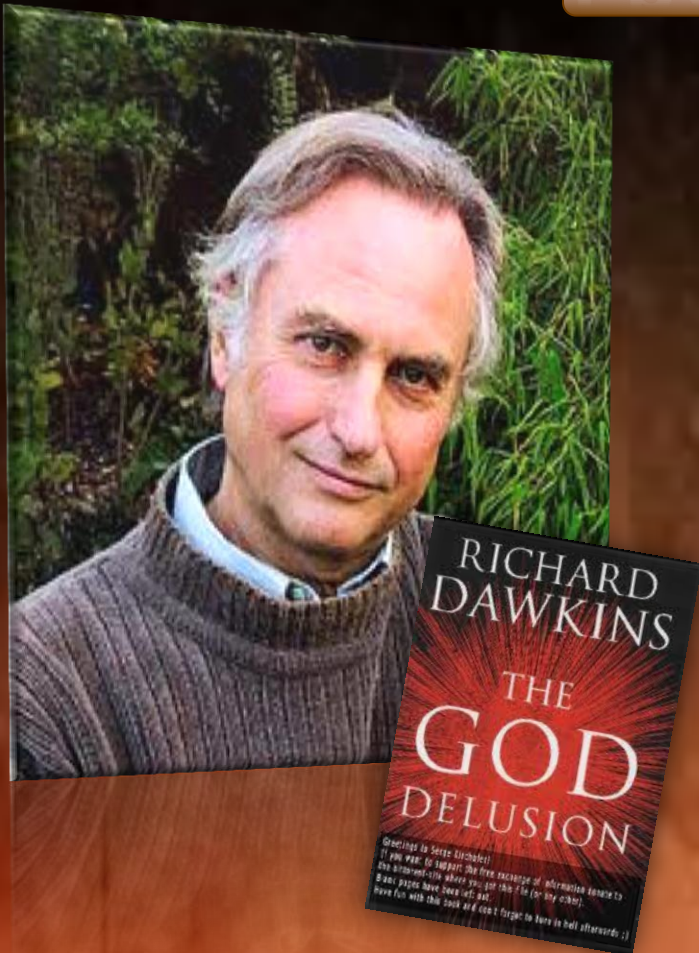
⁹ Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. ¹⁰ For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things *done* in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad. ¹¹ Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences.

- ◆ The Atheist – (Psalm 14:1)
- ◆ The Skeptic – (2 Pet. 3:1-15)
- ◆ The Idolater & Immoral – (1 Cor. 6:9-11; Rev. 21:8)
- ◆ The Good Moral Man – (Acts 10; John 8:24; Rom 3:23; 6:23)

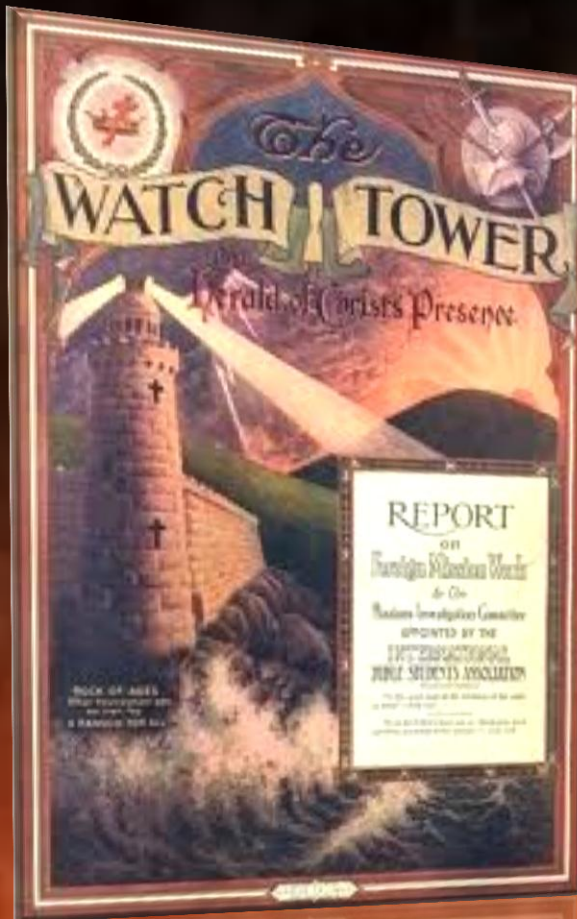


Judgment Day Surprises

The Reality of Judgment

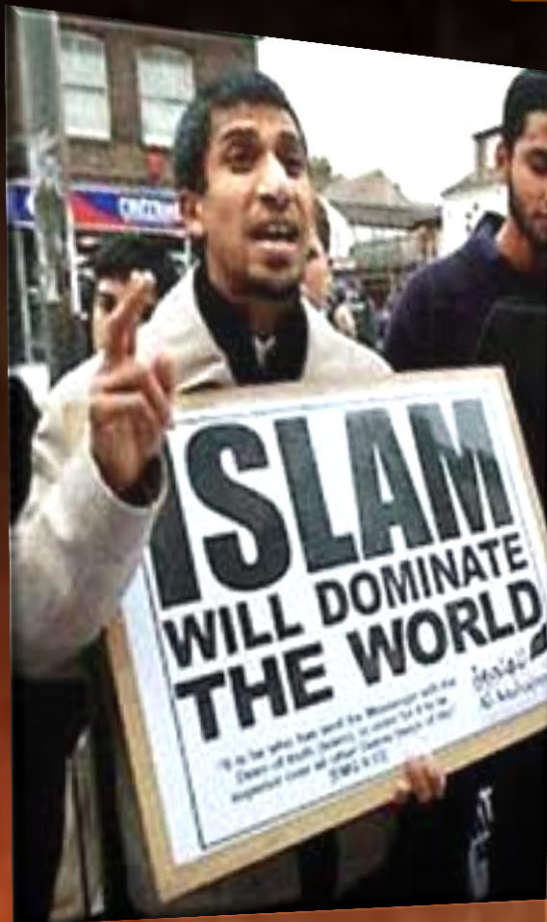
The Professed Believer

- ◆ Those who deny the reality of hell – *J.W.'s; 7th Day Adv.; Etc.-* (Mat. 10:28; 25:41-46; Rev. 21:8)
- ◆ Those who do not believe that God will allow people to go into hell – (Mat. 25:46; 2 Thes. 1:7-9; Rev 21:8)

The Standard of Judgment



The Religious Unbeliever

- ◆ The idolater – Hindu, Buddhist, Etc. – (Heb. 11:6)
- ◆ Muslim, Jew, J.W.'s; Mormons - Etc. – (John 3:16-18; 8:24; 12:48; 14:6; Rom 2:16)
- ◆ The Moralist – (Eph. 2:8,9; Rom. 2:16; 3:23; 6:23)

Judgment Day Surprises

The Standard of Judgment

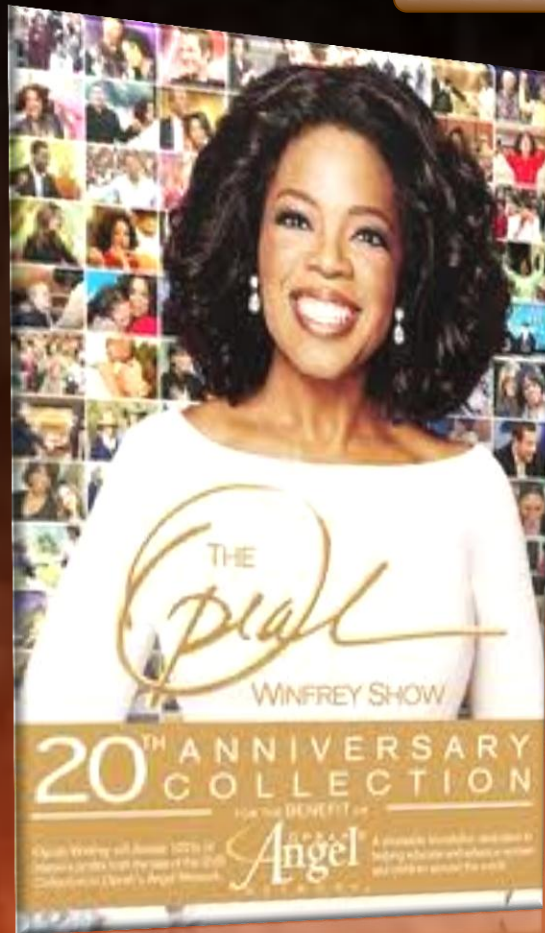
The Professing Believers

- ◆ Catholics – *not the church Catechism or Pope* - (John 12:48)
- ◆ Protestants – *Not creeds of men* - (Rom. 2:16; Gal. 1:6-9; James 2:12)
- ◆ Not Faith Only; Morality; Sincerity; Feelings or Religious Acts – (Jam. 2:14-26; Acts 23:1; 24:16; Rom. 10:1-4; Mat. 7:21-23)



Judgment Day Surprises

The Recipients of Judgment



Every Accountable Unbeliever

- ◆ Atheist; Modernist; Humanist; Skeptic, Etc. – (Rom. 1:18-32)
- ◆ Idolaters; Immoral; Ungodly; Materialist – (Rom. 1:18-32; Gal. 5:19-21; Rev. 21:8)
- ◆ Religious, Moral, Benevolent, Relatively Good – (Rom. 3:9-23; 10:1-3; Mat. 15:7-9; Eph 2:8,9)

Judgment Day Surprises

The Recipients of Judgment

Every Pseudo Believer

- ◆ Those who preach false doctrine – (2 Cor. 11:13-15; 2 Pet. 2:1-3,17)
- ◆ Those who believe false doctrine – (Mat. 15:14; 2 Pet 2:19)
- ◆ All who do not know God and obey NOT the gospel – (2 Thes 1:7-9; Rom. 6:16,17; Acts 17:11)

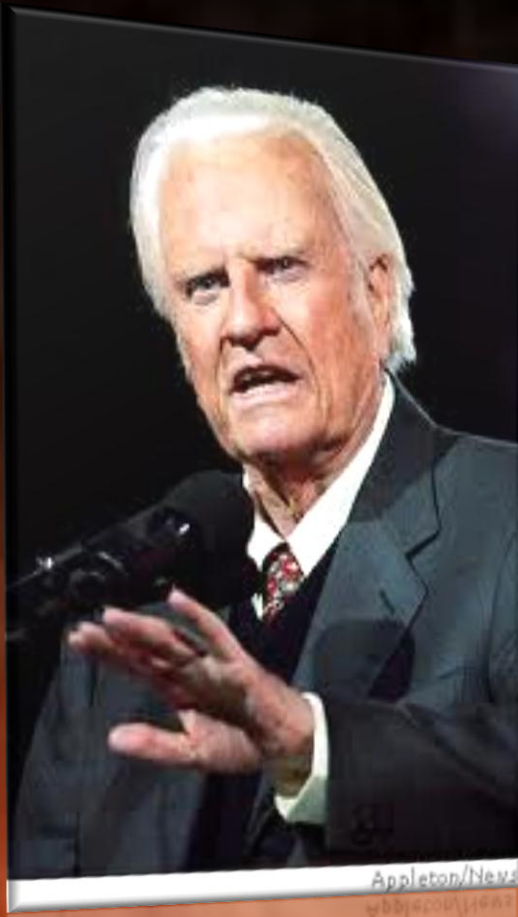


Judgment Day Surprises

The Recipients of Judgment

Every Pseudo Believer

- ◆ Those who have not confessed Christ as the Son of God – (Mat. 10:32,33; John 3:16-18; 12:42)
- ◆ Those who have not repented – (Luke 13:3,5; Acts 17:30,31)
- ◆ Those who have not been baptized into Christ – (Acts 2:38; Rom. 6:3-6; Col. 2:12,13; 1 Pet. 3:21)



Judgment Day Surprises

The Recipients of Judgment

Every Erring Believer

- ◆ Judgment begins with the house of God – (1 Pet 4:17; 2 Cor 5:10)
- ◆ Those who return to the world – (2 Pet 2:20-22; 2 Tim 4:10; Jam 4:4)
- ◆ Those who do not walk in the light & turn from the truth – (1 John 1:5-10; James 5:19:20)
- ◆ The self righteous – (Luke 18:9-14)



Judgment Day Surprises

The Recipients of Judgment

Every Erring Believer

- ◆ Innovators – (2 John 9)
- ◆ Cold formalism – (Amos 8:5; Mal. 1:8; John 4:24)
- ◆ Those who harbor hatred – (Gal. 5:19-21; 1 John 4:7-21)
- ◆ The unprepared – (Mat. 25:1-30)
- ◆ Those who are lukewarm – (Rev 3:14ff; Matt. 25:31-46; Heb 10:24,25)



Judgment Day Surprises

The Recipients of Heaven

Every Faithful Believer

- ◆ Trusting – (Rom 4:19-21)
- ◆ Obedient – (Heb 5:8,9)
- ◆ Loving – (1 John 4:7-11,17)
- ◆ Diligent – (2 Pet. 1:5-10)
- ◆ Persevering – (Rom 5:1-5;
2 Pet. 1:3-9)
