

Some Things Are

Matthew 19:23-26 (NKJV)

²³ Then Jesus said to His disciples, "Assuredly, I say to you that it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven. 24 And again I say to you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." 25 When His disciples heard it, they were greatly astonished, saying, "Who then can be saved?" 26 But Jesus looked at them and said to them, "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

Luke 13:23-24 (NKJV)

Then one said to Him, "Lord, are there few who are saved?" And He said to them,

²⁴ "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I say to you, will seek to enter and will not be able.

Matthew 7:21-23 (NKJV)

²¹ "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²² Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' 23 And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'



- Easy is overrated.
- Easy might appear nice from a distance, but when there's too much ease in life, there aren't very many opportunities for growth, success & fulfillment.
- Many things in striving to live the Christian life are in fact extremely difficult to accomplish but very much worth the effort!
- In fact the easy way is usually the WRONG way! Mat 7:13,14



- Salvation by "faith ONLY" James 2:24
- "Once Saved Always Saved" 2 Pet 1:5-10
- No need to search for truth Acts 17:11,12
- Easier to please self focus on recreation & entertainment rather than doctrine & holiness
 Rom 14:17; 1 Pet 1:13ff
- 2nd Generation Christianity Judges 2:7-10; Rom 10:17

- Easier To Preach Than Practice . . . To Talk The Talk Than Walk The Walk . . . To Instruct Than To Receive Instruction . . .
- Easier To Say "I Want The Truth" Than to Receive It & Apply It!
- Easier To Criticize Than To Help Find A Solution . . .
- Easier To Say "I Love You" Than To Love . . .

- Everything you can think of to be done that is of great value is "easier said than done." (Mat. 13:44,45; Luke 9:23,24,57-62)
 - "I want to go to heaven"
 - "I want to be a godly person"
 - "I want to know God's word"
 - "I want to break a bad habit"
 - "I want to make better use of my time"
 - "I want to help others"
 - "I want a great marriage"
 - "I want to be a great parent"
 - "I want to be great at teaching others the gospel"

None of these things happen automatically - they require much effort!




- Taking consistent, persistent, focused action is easier said than done -(James 2:14-26)

- The key is allowing the Lord to change your heart...






- Obeying the gospel -Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38; 1 John 1:9

 breaking free from sin Eph 6:10-18




- Initial decision Commit to serving the Lord - Josh. 24:15; Rom 6:3-19

- Perseverance Staying the course 1 Cor. 15:58; 1 John 1:9,10; Heb 10:24,25




Matthew 11:28-30 (NKJV)


1 John 5:2-4 (NKJV)
