





³ For consider Him who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself, lest you become weary and discouraged in your souls.







- Eros Carnal, sensual, selfish Not used in NT
- ◆ Stergein Natural love Not used in NT
- Phileo Friendly love More nearly represents tender affection.
- ◆ Agapao— "Love which is awakened by a sense of value in an object which causes one to prize it . . . It is a love of esteem and approbation" (Weust). Act of the will not emotion (Mt. 5:43-48; Mk 12:29-31; Jn. 3:16)

LOOKING unto JESUS We Love What We Value



- → At the heart of Biblical love is the value placed upon the object
- → The degree of value we place upon an object is equivalent to the degree of love we have for it!





A Closer Look At The Character of Love



1 Corinthians 13:4-8 (NKJV)


⁴ Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; ⁵ does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; ⁶ does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; ⁷ bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. ⁸ Love never fails. . . .

A Closer Look At The Character of Love




- "Suffers long" Not quick to punish or retaliate wrongs incurred - associated with mercy.
- "Is kind" sympathetic sweetness of temper, rendering good instead of pain.
- Is not jealous, is not boastful or arrogant - but is meek and humble.

A Closer Look At The Character of Love



- "Does not behave rudely" love always conducts itself with proper decorum arrogance treats others with contempt.
- "Is not selfish" but rather a genuine concern for the well being of other people.
- * "Not provoked" Love does NOT go around with a chip on its shoulder.
- → "Thinks no evil" Love does not dwell
 on evils it has incurred (evil is fertile
 soil for bitterness and resentment)

A Closer Look At The Character of Love



Love does not rejoice in iniquity -

- * Love finds NO pleasure in hearing of the moral weakness of another - love realizes the high "cost" of sin. Sin hurts the sinner & all who love them. (Romans 6:23)
- * Love never encourages someone in wrong-doing love does not tempt another to do evil or act in ways that would cause another to do evil.

 (Romans 1:32; 14:13-15)

A Closer Look At The Character of Love



Love rejoices in the truth -


- * 'Christian love has no wish to veil the truth; it is brave enough to face the truth.' (Barclay p. 137)
- * Love is never ashamed of the truth. (Romans 1:16) Love will speak the truth, in the most difficult of situations. (Eph. 4:15; 2 Tim. 2:2)
- * Love rejoices when the truth is obeyed, returned to, propagated . . .

A Closer Look At The Character of Love



- ◆ "Bears all things" To remain steady under trial, to hold another up - OR to conceal or hide - 1 Pet 4:8.
- → "Believes all things" wants to believe the best until evidence proves otherwise – considers all evidence.
- "Hopes all things" When evidence is adverse - love still hopes for the best.
- "Endures all things" loves sticks it out . . . It doesn't quit under adverse circumstances.

A Closer Look At The Character of Love



Colossians 3:12-14 (NKJV)

¹² Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; 13 bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. 14 But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.

Romans 8:35-39 (NKJV)


Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. ³⁸ For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

- A Conscious Decision ("put on love") -Cannot be forced - an act of the will - Co 3:14
- ♦ Expressed towards the Father & Son in obedience John 14:15,21; 1 John 5:2,3
- → To Be Constant ("walk in love") Ep 5:2
- ★ To Be Our Motive ("serve from love") 1 Co 16:14; Ga 5:13
- To Be Our Glue ("knit together in love") Co 2:2; 3:14; 1 Cor. 8:1
