¹ Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind, for he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, ² that he no longer should live the rest of *his* time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God. ³ For we *have spent* enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles--when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries.

1 Peter 4:1-11 (NKJV)

⁴ In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with *them* in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of *you*. ⁵ They will give an account to Him who is ready to judge the living and the dead. ⁶ For this reason the gospel was preached also to those who are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit. ⁷ But the end of all things is at hand; therefore be serious and watchful in your prayers.

1 Peter 4:1-11 (NKJV)

⁸ And above all things have fervent love for one another, for "love will cover a multitude of sins." ⁹ Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. ¹⁰ As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God. ¹¹ If anyone speaks, *let him speak* as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

"I Resolve To Glorify God!" Arm Yourselves With The Mind of Christ – (4:1)

Arm - equip oneself with the same insight - (BDAG) - Aorist Imperative – decisive action at a given point

Put on the attitude and mindset of Jesus – [Faith, Courage, Hope] - (3:18; Phili. 2:5-10; Rom. 13:12-14; Prov. 23:7)

 Cease from sin - If our attitude and thinking is like Jesus' - then doing what we ought will naturally follow – (Heb 5:7-9; 12:1,2; Ezek. 18:31; Rom. 12:1-3; Eph. 4:22-24; Col. 3:1-10)

"I Resolve To Glorify God!" Not Living To Please Men – But To Please God – (4:2,3)

FROM THIS DAY FORWARD

Do NOT live for self or men –

(lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries), such living is a waste of time and life! - (4:2,3; Eph. 4:17-24; 5:8-18)

Resolve to strive to please God in all we do – (Rom. 12:1,2; Eccl. 12:13; Eph. 5:1; Col. 3:17; 1 Ths. 4:1; 1 John 2:15-17),

"I Resolve To Glorify God!" Willing To Suffer Reproach From The Ungodly – (4:4-6)

* "They think it strange" – old

acquaintances are now persecutors. A changed life provokes hostility from those who reject the gospel - (4:4; 2:12; 3:16; Mat. 5:10-12; Acts 13:45)

*** "They will give an account"** – (4:5; 2 Thes. 1:7-10; 2 Pet. 2:12; Jude 10)

The gospel gives true life - The ungodly may condemn - but God gives life - (4:6; 1 Pet. 2:11; 3:19; Heb 11:13)

"I Resolve To Glorify God!" Taking My Spiritual Duties Seriously – (4:7-11)

Ready for judgment – (4:7; 2 Pet. 3:9-11; John 5:28,29; 12:48,49)

*Serious and watchful in prayer" – (4:7; 5:8; Mt 25:13; Eph 6:18; Col. 4:2)

Fervent love - (4:8; 1 Pet. 1:22; Col. 3:14; 1 Thes 3:12; Prov. 10:12; Jas. 5:20)


Be hospitable without grumbling – (4:9; Rom 12:13; Heb. 13:2; Phili 2:14)

Diligent in service as good stewards – (4:10,11; Rom 12:6-8; 1 Cor. 4:2)
