







- ◆God delivered them with a mighty hand from Egypt Ex. 3:8; chs 7-14

26; 1 Kings 8:53




- Not satisfied with God's provisions and turned in their hearts back to Egypt − Exodus 16,17; Acts 7:39
- ◆ Failed to enter the promise land because of doubt – Numbers 13,14




- ★ Entered and possessed the land under Joshua's leadership Joshua; Judges

- ★ Failed to drive out all of the inhabitants of the land Joshua 13:13; 16:10;17:13


Joshua 23:11-13 (NKJV)



God Warns Them About The Actions Of A King:


- *Take your children to work for him (vs. 11-13)
- *Take the best of your fields, your vineyards (vs. 14)
- *He will take a tenth of all that you have (vs. 15,17)
- *He will take your servants for his work (vs. 16)
- You may become his servants (vs. 17)
- *You will cry out because of your king (vs. 18)







- ◆The catalyst for the change was rebellion
- ◆The change would have long-lasting results
- **◆**God allowed the change



- ◆ Israel became idolaters became like the Gentiles destroyed
- ◆ In the NT some local churches reflected the cities in which they were located – needed to repent
- ◆ The church Post NT incorporated secular systems of organization – incorporated pagan practices – fell away



- **→** Evil speech (4:31)
- **♦** Coarse jesting (5:4)
- ◆ Wrath, anger, malice (4:31)
- **♦** Fornication (5:3)
- **→** All uncleanness (5:3)
- → Filthiness (5:4)

In Our Affections

- ◆ Using mind altering drugs ?

- ★ Respect worldly wisdom over God's word . . . ?

In Our Morals

1 Corinthians 6:9-10 (NKJV) ⁹ Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, 10 nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

In Our Morals

- ◆ Our view and acceptance of those who practice immorality – (homosexuality; sex before and outside of marriage; adultery; etc.)
- **◆** Acceptance leads to practice -
- ◆ Our view and treatment of marriage Mat 19:9; Heb 13:4

No, but we will dress immodestly, that we may be like the nations around us.

In Our Apparel

- ◆ God commands that we adorn ourselves modestly- 1 Timothy 2:9-10
- ◆ God has always set standards on modesty and nakedness -Genesis 3:21
- ◆ God teaches that immodesty causes others to sin – Prov. 7:10; Mat 5:28-29

No, but we will incorporate paganism & secularism, that we may be like the nations around us.

In Our Religion

- ◆ Our worship must be in spirit and truth – John 4:24; Lev 10:1-3
- ◆ Our doctrine & practice must be of God not man – Mat 15:7-9; 1 Tim 4:13-16; 2 John 9
- ★ All we say and do must be authorized by the Lord Col. 3:17; Luke 6:46


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
In Our Religion

- ◆ In organization (larger than the local church; laity / clergy distinctions; institutionalism)
- ◆ In worship (Mec. Instrumental music; Lord's supper; unsound preaching; emotionalism; entertainment)
- ★ In doctrine (doesn't matter; salvation; eschatology; nature of God & man; morality; etc.)
- ◆ In work (recreation / social reform)

We Are Warned About Worldliness:


- We will lose our souls and suffer eternal separation from God in hell.


