


Matthew 26:26-29 (NKJV)

- ²⁶ And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body."
- ²⁷ Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you.
- ²⁸ For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.
- ²⁹ But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."




"Take eat . . . Drink from it all of you" (Mat. 26:26,27)



- **This is My body** − The unleavened bread signifies the flesh of Jesus (Mat. 26:26; Mk 14:22; Lk 22:19; 1 Cor 11:24)
- ◆ "This is My blood of the new covenant" The fruit of the vine signifies the blood of the new covenant which was shed for our sins (Mat 26:27,28; Mk 14:24; Luke 22:20; 1 Cor. 11:25)

¹⁹ And He took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me."

²⁰ Likewise He also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup *is* the new covenant in My blood, which is shed for you.

Exodus 12:11-13 (NKJV)

¹¹ And thus you shall eat it: with a belt on your waist, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand. So you shall eat it in haste. The Lord's Supper Is A Judgment Against:




- The contention that sin isn't that bad

- Every apathetic and half-hearted attempt to serve God




- **→ A Memorial** (1 Cor. 11:24-25)

- ★ A serious act failure to properly discern the Lord's body is to bring condemnation upon ourselves - (1 Cor 11:20-22; 27-30; 3:17)






















Isaiah 53:1-12 (NKJV)

¹ Who has believed our report? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed? ² For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him. ³ He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.



Isaiah 53:1-12 (NKJV)

⁴ Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵ But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed. ⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; We have turned, every one, to his own way; And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.



Isaiah 53:1-12 (NKJV)

⁷ He was oppressed and He was afflicted, Yet He opened not His mouth; He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, And as a sheep before its shearers is silent, So He opened not His mouth. ⁸ He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.

⁹ And they made His grave with the wicked-- But with the rich at His death, Because He had done no violence, Nor was any deceit in His mouth. ¹⁰ Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.

¹¹ He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities. ¹² Therefore I will divide Him a portion with the great, And He shall divide the spoil with the strong, Because He poured out His soul unto death, And He was numbered with the transgressors, And He bore the sin of many, And made intercession for the transgressors.



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
